GENERAL INFORMATION

The Alabama National Guard Educational Assistance Program (ANGEAP) is a state student assistance program established by the Legislature of the State of Alabama and is designed to provide educational assistance to eligible Alabama National Guard members enrolled in a certificate program at an accredited community or technical college or a degree program at an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning located within the State of Alabama.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to receive assistance through Alabama National Guard Educational Assistance Program (ANGEAP), the student must:

- 1) Be at least (17) years of age or older.
- 2) Have completed basic training.
- 3) Be an active member in good standing of a federally recognized unit of the Alabama National Guard.
- 4) Pursuing the **first** baccalaureate, graduate or postgraduate degree utilizing ANGEAP assistance.
- 5) Be enrolled in an approved workforce development program, certificate or degree program within the State of Alabama.
- 6) Be enrolled in an eligible institution, including an accredited college, technical college, university, or work force training program.
- 7) Be making satisfactory academic progress (SAP) as determined by the eligible institution.
- 8) Maintain at least 2.00 cumulative GPA as an Undergraduate or 3.00 GPA as a Graduate at the end of each academic term.
- 9) Have completed and have a valid Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file, unless exempt as a dual or concurrent enrolled high school student.
- 10) Demonstrate a financial need of at least \$100.00.
- 11) Submit a sign promissory note and repayment agreement.
- 12) Can receive assistance for only **one** baccalaureate, graduate or postgraduate degree.

USE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

Section 7(b) of the Privacy Act of 1974 (5 U.S.C. 522a) requires that when any Federal, State, or local government agency requests an individual to disclose his/her social security account number, that individual must also be advised whether that disclosure is mandatory or voluntary, by what statutory or other authority the number is solicited, and what uses will be made of it.

Accordingly, applicants are advised that disclosure of their social security account number (SSN) is required as a condition for participation in the Alabama National Guard Educational Assistance Program, in view of the practical administrative difficulties which the Program would encounter in maintaining adequate program records without the continued use of the SSN.

The SSN will be used to verify the identity of the applicant and as an account number (identifier) throughout the life of the grant in order to record necessary data accurately. As an identifier, the SSN is used in such Program activities as: determining program eligibility, certifying school attendance, making and verifying grant payments, and maintaining records of grant payments.

Authority for requiring the disclosure of an applicant's SSN is in section 7(a)2 of the Privacy Act, which provides that an agency may require disclosure of an individual's SSN as a condition for the granting of a right, benefit, or privilege provided by law.
